ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English this term we will be focusing on writing simple sentences ensuring that we use full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. Our daily phonics lessons are important to widen our phonic knowledge.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths we will be focussing place value, including, but not limited to, ordering numbers, number correspondence and comparing numbers before we move onto addition and subtraction within 10.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>During this half term, children will be learning about everyday materials and their properties. We will focus on the difference between objects and materials and natural materials vs man-made. We will spend some time looking at our solar system as well.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>We will explore different uses of ICT in our classroom including using chromebooks for research. Our main focus will be on e-safety and the dangers of cyberbullying.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>During our topic lessons, we will be looking at directional language, using a timeline and looking at events within living memory. We will spend time learning about Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin and their adventure to the moon.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>This half term we will be focusing on Christianity and Humanism. We will be looking at different places of worship and we will discuss and answer the following question: What is a church?</p>
<p>DT/Art</p> 	<p>During the first half term, the children will apply their art and design skills in creating drawings of the 8 planets and looking at moving axel. They will focus on planning and evaluating their makes.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE will focus on multi skills. We will aim to master basic movements as well as develop balance, agility and coordination.</p>
