ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English this term we will be focussing on our sentence structure, including capital letters, full stops and finger spaces as well as adjectives. Our daily phonics lessons are important to widen our phonic knowledge.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths we will firstly be focussing on subtraction, investigating a range of methods to achieve this, fact families and how addition and subtraction facts are related. We will then move on to shapes, both 2D and 3D and place value with numbers up to 20. Finally we will move onto comparing and grouping numbers and objects.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>During this half term, children will be learning about animals and their habitats. We will focus on plants and seeds and carry out an investigation by planting some bulbs in our garden.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>We will explore different uses of ICT in our classroom including using chromebooks for research. Our main focus will be on e-safety and the dangers of cyberbullying.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography and History</p> 	<p>During our topic lessons, we will be looking at directional language, reading maps, creating maps and understanding how to use a key.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>This half term we will be focusing on the hindu celebration of Diwali, the festival of lights that is held every autumn. We will be learning about the story of Rama and Sita alongside this.</p>
<p>DT/Art</p> 	<p>During the first half term, the children will apply their art and design skills by looking at colour mixing, fine line drawings and designing and evaluating woodland crowns.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Our PE will focus on dance. We will aim to master basic rhythmic patterns and choreograph a routine by the end of the term.</p>
