
GOODBYE TO MRS KENISTON





Free Entry

The ideal place for a family day out and one of the largest country parks in the region. Situated less than three miles from Peterborough city centre, its varied landscapes make it the favourite destination for thousands of visitors throughout the year. Whether you're looking to walk, cycle, try some watersports, enjoy a cup of tea in one of the cafés, go fishing or just explore the meadows, lakes and woodland, there's something for everyone.

Half-term activities available from £1 for a nature trail (no booking needed) to £10 for archery sessions and broomstick making (booking required).

Eating out deals this half-term

Kids eat free at **Morrisons cafe** when an adult spends £4.50 or more on a meal.

At **Asda** cafes this half-term, kids can eat for £1. Each child is entitled to a meal when accompanying adults spend £1.

Kids can eat for £1 at **Bella Italia** with the purchase of every adult main course. Mon-Thurs, 4-6pm.

Kids eat free in all **Tesco cafes** from October 17-28. Accompanying adults must have a Clubcard and spend 60p or more.
