Tuesday 9 May 2023	English grammar, punctuation and spelling papers 1 and 2
Wednesday 10 May 2023	English reading
Thursday 11 May 2023	Mathematics papers 1 and 2
Friday 12 May 2023	Mathematics paper 3

All children are invited to come in for Breakfast Club in the morning. Even if they don't want breakfast, it is a chance for them to come and chat with friends and settle any nerves they may have.

Children will be completing the tests in small groups throughout the day with the adults they are familiar with.
