## PE- Wednesday


PE kits should be worn into school on PE days. Black shorts or trousers and a white/plain t-shirt is the expected kit. No costume jewellery or earrings please.

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Phonics	This term in phonics we will continue to learn 4 sounds each week. Please check your child's phonic book so you know which new sound we have learnt and can practice at home. Children will access phonics as a whole class session each morning, with a second recap session in the afternoon focussed on blending and word building.
l itement	We will look at a range of key texts such as Elmer, The colour monster and The Toys Party. Within our sessions we will look at word building and building sentences, using a capital letter and full stop.
Maths	In Maths we will be starting the White Rose Maths scheme; 'It's me123!' and 'Light and dark'. Maths will focus on numbers personal to us, recognising and representing numbers to 5 and careful counting and understanding of the composition of number. We will also look at a range of 2D shapes and will be printing with these.

# ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING


### Outdoor Learning
