

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

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	English	In writing, we will be looking at adventure stories and non-chronological reports. We will be focusing on creating grammatically correct sentences, using expanded noun phrases, imperative verbs, prepositions and dialogue.
	Maths	In Maths we will continue looking at multiplication and division with particular emphasis on the 3, 4 and 8 times tables and the formal written method for these. This will be followed by a unit on length and perimeter.
	Science	There is no specific science topic this half term.
	Computing	In ICT, we will be looking at sequencing sounds using 'Scratch'. As always, we will continue to work on keeping safe using technology.
