### Reading

Children need to read for at least ten minutes every day in order to help them improve their fluency of reading. The children will be responsible for changing their reading books when they complete the book they have read. *Please can parents sign the reading record to say you have heard your child read at least once a week*

### PE - important changes.

## CLASS NOTICES

<b>English</b> 	<p>In English we will be reading 'Demon Dentist by David Walliams' and using this to write a narrative with dialogue.</p> <p>We will also be reading 'The Gut Garden by Katie Brosnan' and using this to write an explanation text about the digestive system.</p>
<b>Maths</b> 	<p>In Maths we will be learning to multiply and divide by 10 and 100 and also to multiply and divide 2 and 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number. We will also be learning to measure and recognise equivalent lengths. We will find the perimeter of rectangles, rectilinear shapes and polygons.</p>
<b>Science</b> 	<p>In science, we will be learning about teeth and digestion. We will be learning to identify the different types of teeth and their simple function. We will investigate tooth decay and learn how to look after our teeth. We will learn how saliva starts the digestive process. We will compare the digestive system of a human with that of another animal.</p>
<b>Computing</b> 	<p>We will focus on internet safety and how we can protect ourselves and our identity online. We will consider the differences between real and online friendships. We will learn about cyberbullying and how to identify and stop it.</p>

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<b>R.E.</b> 	<p>In RE, we will be learning about Sikhs and what they believe. We will be learning about the first and Last Human Gurus, The Khalsa and the Five Ks.</p>
<b>MUSIC</b> 	<p>In music, we will be learning and performing the song; Stop - a rap song about bullying. We will learn about the interrelated dimensions of music through games, singing and composing.</p>
<b>Art</b> 	<p>We will be exploring Still Life art. We will look at the work of Paul Cezanne and create our own still life sketches. We will use our sketches to sculpture still life pieces from clay.</p>
<b>P.E</b> 	<p>4AC will be completing a unit of Contemporary Dance this term. This unit is based on the Royal Opera House ballet <i>Alice's Adventures in Wonderland</i>. Children will work towards choreographing and performing a dance sequence. 4RW will be swimming.</p>
<b>MFL</b> 	<p>Year 4 will be continuing our MFL journey with Spanish. Our theme this term will be the Cafe as we learn how to order in a cafe in Spanish.</p>
