ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Phonics	This term in phonics we will be learning our phase 3 phonemes, and will practise applying them. Children will access phonics as a whole class, we will learn 4 new digraphs a week with a review day on a Friday. Please look out for your child's homework, in your child's new phonic book and practice these at home.
Literacy	We will look at a range of books this term starting with the text of Supertato, then moving onto Non fiction books. Within our sessions we will look at building sentences, using a capital letter and a full stop.
Maths	In maths we will be using the White Rose Maths scheme; 'Alive in 5, growing 6,7,8 and building 9&10.' Maths will focus on addition, subtraction and building our number bonds to 5 and then to 10. We will also look at Length, height and capacity.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Topic This term we will ask the question 'Do all superheroes wear capes?' We will start the term thinking about Superheroes, making our own superhero outfits and equipment. We will move on to learning about heroes within our community and the people we can call for help such as the police, fire and medical services. We will look at the location of Peterborough and find Highlees on Maps. In art we will focus on exploring 3D Art & materials. We will be thinking about how Music we join materials together and learning new methods to join, dependent on the materials. We will make a range of models such as our own potato heroes and 999 vehicles



Our PE lessons will be gymnastics with a focus on demonstrating strength, balance, coordination and stability; when balancing and making shapes with our bodies.
