Reading

Children take part in daily reading sessions and activities in school. We ask that you read at home with your child everyday. Please bring your child's reading book in on a **Wednesday** so they can select a new book to take home.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Phonics	We are continuing to use our phonetic knowledge to help us to read and write. This half term we will be focusing on using our phonics to help us to read and write sentences. We will be moving on to Phase 4 phonics.
Literacy	In Literacy we will be exploring a range of texts linked to our 'Magical Gardens' topic. We will be looking at some traditional tales including Jack and the Beanstalk as well as some non-fiction texts. We will be writing simple sentences about our beans that we are growing in school.
Maths	In Maths this half term we will be ordering numbers to 10, representing the numbers 9 and 10 and looking at the composition of 9 and 10. We will be exploring these numbers in lots of practical ways both indoors and outdoors.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING



This half term we will be focusing on seasonal changes - looking at Spring and how this compares to other seasons. We will continue to explore our school grounds and complete lots of exciting activities outdoors!

UTW



We will be looking at growth and changes over time with plants and animals. We will be planting our own beans in school and watching them grow over a few weeks. We will observe them closely during this time, finding out what they need to grow.



During this half term we will be learning about the artist Andy Goldsworthy. We will be exploring his natural artwork and re-creating our own with natural resources that we find outside.



Children will develop their fundamental movement skills. Fundamental skills will include balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and travelling. Children will develop gross motor skills through a range of activities. They will learn how to stay safe using space, working independently and with a partner.
