Class Text

Reading

All children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home. Children will bring a reading record home so they can track their reading and share this with you. We would appreciate it if you could sign this off each week and talk to your child about what they are reading. Books will be changed when children have completed an Accelerated Reading Quiz.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

English 	<p>In English this term we will be focusing on retrieval, vocabulary and inference skills when answering questions linked to our class text (The Wolf Wilder), images and extracts. Our writing will focus on a narrative that builds tension; a persuasive text and a formal letter.</p>
Maths 	<p>In Maths, we will focus on fractions (comparing, ordering, calculating and finding fractions of amounts). If your child is still unsure of their times table facts, please encourage them to practise regularly at home. Without this quick recall, working with fractions is made much more challenging.</p>
Science 	<p>During the term, the children will be learning about classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics and identifying how plants and animals are adapted to suit their environments and that this adaptation can lead to evolution.</p>
Computing 	<p>We will be creating web pages. This unit begins with reviewing existing websites, planning our own web pages, considering copyright, previewing, creating navigation paths and evaluating our own and others' work.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Geography and History 	<p>We will be studying the polar oceans and regions of the world; identifying the position and significance of lines of latitude and longitude; extreme weather; and the impact of humans on these environments. We will also discuss climate and climate change, including steps we can take to reduce our environmental impact.</p>
R.E. 	<p>This term we continue to focus on Christianity and discussing what matters most to Christians and to Humanists?</p>
DT/Art 	<p>During this term, the children will focus on perspective and painting. We will practise creating perspective using a vanishing point in our work.</p>
P.E. 	<p>Our PE will focus on netball and hockey. We will continue to take lessons outside as often as possible, so please wear warm PE kit and outdoor shoes.</p>
