

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

| <p><b>English</b></p>     | <p>In writing, this term we will be writing a recount using the first person and chronological order of key events. We will also researched historical sources and present our findings as a non-fiction reports about Anglo-Saxons &amp; Vikings.</p>  |
| <p><b>Maths</b></p>       | <p>In Maths, we will be looking at decimals, recapping our knowledge of bonds to 10 and 100. We will compare, order and round decimals. Then we will look at using the four operations to help with ordering and estimating money as well as finding change.</p>                                |
| <p><b>Science</b></p>    | <p>In Science this term, we will be continuing our work on electricity, looking at closed and open circuits and how switches work.</p>  |
| <p><b>Computing</b></p>  | <p>This half term, we will be looking at photo editing. We will develop our understanding of how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can then be re-saved and re-used. We will consider the impact that editing can have, and evaluate the effectiveness of our choices.</p> |

| <p><b>Geography and History</b></p>  | <p>This term we will learning about the Anglo - Saxons and the Vikings and what impact they made the world's history. We will continue developing our knowledge of using atlases by locating where they originated from.</p>             |
| <p><b>R.E.</b></p>                   | <p>This half term, we will learn why Jesus is inspiring to some people. Then we will look at what can we learn from religions when deciding between right and wrong.</p>   |
| <p><b>Art/D. T/ Music</b></p>        | <p>In Art, we will construct jewellery that resembles Anglo-Saxons' pendants and crosses.<br/>In DT, this term we will be creating models of Anglo - Saxon jewellery using clay, string and different types of buttons and sequence.</p> |
| <p><b>P.E.</b></p>                  | <p>In PE this half term, we will explore the principles of striking and fielding. We will also expand on our knowledge of the different roles of bowler, wicket keeper, fielder and batter.</p>  |
