As you are aware Dolce have now taken over the school lunches.



Pre-orders can be made up to a term in advance by using your SchoolGrid account. Children can still book on the day in the classroom.

Please make sure that any pre-ordered meals are cancelled by using your SchoolGrid account if your child changes their mind and brings a packed lunch from home, or if they are going to be absent for any reason. This must be done no later than 9:30am on the day of the meal. If meals are not cancelled before 9:30am they will still be prepared and food may be wasted.

If your child is coming into school late for any reason an order for their lunch needs to be booked before 9:30am. You can do this by placing a pre-order on your SchoolGrid account or you can call the school office and they can add the meal for you so your child has a lunch booked for that day.
