Reading

Your child will be given a colour banded book to read at home with an adult. When your child has read their book, the adult needs to write a comment in their reading record book. Please encourage your child to read at home every day for at least 10 minutes. Adults in school will read with your child weekly. When your child has finished reading their book more than once, it will be their responsibility to change it for a new one.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

| English  | Our key texts for this term are; Tell me a Dragon and Small Knight George and the Royal Chocolate Cake. We will be using drama for writing techniques to help the children develop their vocabulary for writing. |
| Maths  | We will be working on numbers within 100 and understanding their value. We will continue practising our counting forwards and backwards. As well as writing numbers as words and forming numbers correctly, we will also learn to add and subtract these numbers. |
| Science  | This unit is called 'Animals Including Humans - life cycles'. We will be ordering the stages of different life cycles and children will be taught that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. |
| Computing  | In ICT, we will be looking at technology in the world around us, for example at home and in school. We will also learn what impact this technology has within our lives and its uses. |
| R.E.  | In RE, we will be investigating how Christians might follow Jesus' example of being kind to people. The learning will be based on Jesus summing up the 10 commandments in the Old Testament into two commandments. |

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

| History  | In History, we will be learning about the monarchy, children will learn about where Kings and Queens live and how these have changed over time. Children will use historical resources like pictures to discuss similarities and differences and will also look at some Kings and Queens from history. |
| MUSIC  | We will be learning and performing the song 'Hands, Feet and Heart' as a class. Whilst learning the song, your child will learn different dimensions of music such as pulse, rhythm, and pitch. |
| D & T  | In D & T, we will explore how mechanisms like linkages and pivots can be used to create movement in designs. Children will design and construct a monster with moving parts, using creative materials to represent features like fur, scales, and claws. |
| P.E.  | Our PE lessons this term will focus on Invasion games. Children will understand what being in possession means and they will support a teammate to do this. They will learn that scoring goals is an attacking skill and that stopping goals is a defending skill. Children will explore how to gain possession and how to mark an opponent. Furthermore, they will apply simple tactics when attacking and defending. |
