# ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p>In Writing, we will be looking at adventure stories, scene settings and character descriptions. We will be focusing on creating grammatically correct sentences, using expanded noun phrases, imperative verbs, prepositions and dialogue.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>This term we will be focusing on place value and the meaning of digits and number. We will be adding and subtracting up to 3 digit numbers. We will be using all four operations in our 6 A Day challenges.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>In Science, we will be looking at 'Animals including Humans'. We will focus on the right types and amount of nutrition- looking at the different food groups and creating a healthy meal. We will also look at how energy is needed to make muscles move and keep body systems working well.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>In ICT, we will be focusing on how to log on and access our Google Classroom accounts as well as looking at computing systems and networks.</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today? We will be looking at how Christianity is celebrated throughout Britain and how people show their faith in different ways.</p>

<p><b>Geography and History</b></p> 	<p>This term's project will teach children about the history of Early Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, including changes to people and lifestyle caused by ingenuity, invention and technological advancement.</p>
<p><b>Music</b></p> 	<p>Year 3 will be focusing their learning around one song: 'Let Your Spirit Fly'. This unit will look at the dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc). Children will continue to listen and appraise the music.</p>
<p><b>DT</b></p> 	<p>In D&amp;T, children will be introduced to electricity as part as a functional product. To understand the electrical systems and circuits they will design and make a torch.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>Year 3 will be having a Sports Coach teach every Thursday. This term we will be looking at ball skills, coordination, moving and catching and the fundamentals of PE on Tuesdays.</p>
<p><b>MFL</b></p> 	<p>Year 3 will be starting their MFL journey with Spanish. We will look at the alphabet, numbers, counting and basic greetings.</p>
