## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>English</b></p> 	<p>In English this term, we will be focusing on retrieval skills needed for answering questions linked to our text "Treason" by Berlie Doherty. We will be writing to entertain by writing a narrative, including a setting description about Tudor London. We will be writing a formal letter to persuade.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be learning place value up to a 6 digit number and how to solve the four operations using their formal methods. Then we will be applying this knowledge while solving problems.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p>During the term, the children will be learning about Forces. We will be completing various investigations and learning how to make a test fair.</p>
<p><b>Computing</b></p> 	<p>This term, we will learn how to share information on a computer system and network. We will continue learning about E-safety and how to stay safe when using all types of technology.</p>
<p><b>R.E.</b></p> 	<p>This term, we will be focusing on Judaism, including Rosh Hashanah, and with a theme of forgiveness. We will also learn about Yom Kippur and how Jewish people celebrate this.</p>

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>Geography and History</b></p> 	<p>During the first half term, we will be looking at Life during the Tudor Era, in particular, how Tudors changed Peterborough. We will learn about life under the reign of King Henry VIII and compare Tudor Britain to modern day Britain including comparing landmarks on maps.</p>
<p><b>Art</b></p> 	<p>In Art, we will be learning to use typography - creating and arranging letters and words on a page to help communicate ideas or emotions. We will use techniques learnt to create a visual maps.</p>
<p><b>Music</b></p> 	<p>In Music, we will be focusing on the song 'Livin' on a prayer'. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, we will listen and appraise other classic rock songs.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>Y5HD have a Sports Coach helping with PE on a Friday focusing on Hockey developing dribbling, receiving and passing skills. We will then learn different strokes in tennis and apply rules, skills and principles to play against an opponent.. Y5HD will be swimming on a Monday.</p>
<p><b>MFL</b></p> 	<p>Year 5 will be continuing our MFL journey with Spanish. We will be learning about describing family and friends giving basic information about people.</p>
