Reading

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>CLL</p> 	<p>This half term we are continuing to focus on using our phonics to write words. We will also be looking at how to structure a simple sentence and write them independently. We will be writing some facts about people who help us and information that we have found out about them.</p> <p>In phonics, we will continue to learn new sounds within phase 3 and apply these to our reading and writing.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths this half term, we will be exploring numbers to 5. We will be comparing numbers to 5 and looking at the composition of 4 and 5. We will do this through lots of practical activities in both the indoor and outdoor classroom.</p> <p>We will also compare mass and begin to explore capacity.</p> <p>Towards the end of half term, we will learn about length and height using non-standard measures.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Welly walks</p> 	<p>Children will continue to have a fortnightly 'Welly Walk' session. This half term we will be focusing on seasonal changes - looking at Winter and how this compares to other seasons.</p>
<p>UTW</p> 	<p>We will be exploring different occupations within our community. We will also be looking at maps and where we can find some of our local services e.g. doctors, dentist, library etc. We will then create our own maps.</p>
<p>EAD</p> 	<p>We have a new hospital role play area in the classroom where children are acting out the role of paramedics, doctors, nurses and patients.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>EYFS Ball Skills Children will develop ball skills through the topic of 'minibeasts'. Children will develop ball skills such as rolling and receiving a ball, throwing to a target, bouncing and catching, dribbling with feet and kicking a ball.</p>
