ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In Writing, we will be looking at writing a diary and creating a non-chronological report. We will be focusing on creating grammatically correct sentences, using expanded noun phrases, imperative verbs, prepositions and dialogue.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will continue looking at multiplication and division with particular emphasis on the 3, 4 and 8 times tables and the formal written method for these. This will be followed by a unit on length and perimeter.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>In Science, we will first look at Forces and Magnets. We will then move on to Rocks and how they are formed and categorised.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>In ICT, we will explore internet safety by examining topics such as online bullying, appropriate online behavior and expectations, and the potential impact of a child's online presence.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>We will be learning about different religious and spiritual ways of life, about prayer. This will include the practice, symbols, words, and significance of prayer, as well as some key beliefs about prayer, so that pupils can develop thoughtful ideas and viewpoints of their own about prayer.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Geography</p> 	<p>This term's project will introduce children to map-making and help them identify both physical and human features in their local area. Additionally, we will explore volcanoes and their locations around the world.</p>
<p>MUSIC</p> 	<p>We will be doing a unit of work focused around one song: Three Little Birds- a reggae song for children by Bob Marley. The children will be listening, singing and contrasting different music by various composers as well as learning musical notes.</p>
<p>DT</p> 	<p>In DT, we will be studying shapes and applying this knowledge to create strong and secure structures.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>Year 3 will be having a Sports Coach in to teach every Tuesday. They will be working in pairs and groups choreographing ideas for different dances.</p>
<p>MFL</p> 	<p>Year 3 will be continuing our MFL journey with Spanish. We will still look at the greetings, asking people their name, the alphabet and pronouncing letter names.</p>
