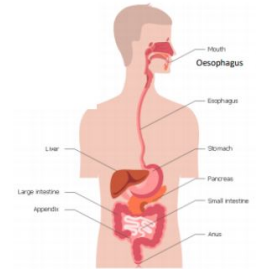
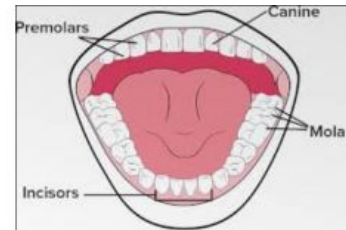

CLASS NOTICES

<p>English</p> 	<p>In English, we are exploring poetry inspired by our science topic on teeth, using similes, metaphors and repetition to create expressive verses. Alongside this, we are developing our non-fiction writing skills by producing detailed non-chronological reports about digestion, focusing on clear structure, factual language and technical vocabulary</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be learning to multiply and divide 2 and 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number. We will also be learning to measure and recognise equivalent lengths. We will find the perimeter of rectangles, rectilinear shapes and polygons. We will be learning to partition mixed numbers and understand improper fractions.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>In Science, we will be learning about teeth and digestion. We will be learning to identify the different types of teeth and their simple function. We will investigate tooth decay and learn how to look after our teeth. We will learn how saliva starts the digestive process. We will compare the digestive system of a human with that of another animal.</p>
<p>Computing</p> 	<p>In Computing, we will be looking at Programming. We will be learning to program a computer by typing commands and design a program that includes count- controlled loops. We will continue to work on keeping safe using technology.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>In RE, we will be focusing on Christianity looking at the key question - 'Why do Christians call the day that Jesus died 'Good Friday?'' We will learn about Holy Week and the Easter story.</p>
<p>MUSIC</p> 	<p>In Music, we will be learning and performing the song Lean on me by Bill Withers. We will learn about the interrelated dimensions of music through games, singing and composing.</p>
<p>DT/Art</p> 	<p>In Art, we will be sketching different animals focusing on shape and outline</p>
<p>PSHE</p> 	<p>In PSHE, we will be looking at 'Healthy Me.' We will learn to recognise how different friendship are formed and how I fit into them</p>
<p>P.E</p> 	<p>We have a Sports Coach helping us with PE on Tuesdays and he will be focusing on dance and gymnastics (Chestnut class) . On Monday Palm class will be learning to swim with qualified swimming instructors. This will then swap over.</p>
<p>SPANISH</p> 	<p>In Spanish, we will learn about 'In a Spanish Cafe' where we will be make polite requests about what I want to eat and drink</p>
