Reading

The children will read for at least 10 minutes every day in school and we hope parents will do the same at home. The children will have a levelled reader that will be changed weekly. ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>English</p> 	<p>In reading we will focus on developing inference skills for answering questions linked to the text we are reading. Our writing will be focused on retelling the key events from the character's point of view. We will also analyse the features of a letter and ingredients of a good sentence.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be developing our multiplication and division skills and learning to apply these skills to problem solving tasks. We will also be looking at different ways to measure. We will be measuring lengths and heights using a ruler; mass using grams and kilogram and capacity using litres and millilitres.</p>
<p>Science</p> 	<p>In Science, we will examine plant growth. We will be investigating, seeds, bulbs and plants in order to determine the conditions required for germination and healthy plant growth. We will do this by planting seeds and recording data.</p>
<p>Computin</p> 	<p>This half term we will develop our understanding of data and information. We will learn about labelling, grouping, and searching in relation to data and information. We will also be covering e-safety in every lesson.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>History</p> 	<p>In History, we explore the lives, journeys, and remarkable adventures of influential polar explorers who have contributed to national and international achievements. We will describe significant events using a range of historical sources and create a timeline to represent our findings.</p>
<p>R.E.</p> 	<p>This term we will continue to learn about the Jewish faith. We will explore some of the objects that might be found in a Jewish home and how they link to daily life. We will also look at key celebrations such as Shabbat and Hanukkah.</p>
<p>Art</p> 	<p>In Art, we will explore sculpture and 3D artwork. We will experiment with pinching, scratching and joining techniques. Then, we will create a clay house tile that has recognisable features made by both impressing objects into the surface and by joining simple shapes together.</p>
<p>P.E.</p> 	<p>In PE we will build on our understanding of movement. We will developed our awareness of space and explore how our bodies can move to express an idea, mood, character or feeling.</p>
