As the weather gets warmer, please ensure that your child has a summer hat and water bottle in school every day. All children children will still need wellington boots for the garden.

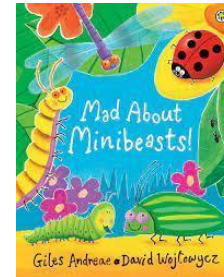
Please make sure your child has a spare bag of clothes on their peg, this is in case they get wet in the water tray.

'Are we mad about minibeasts?'

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Phonics 	This term in phonics we will be consolidating our phase 3 phonemes, and practising applying them in longer words. We will begin to move onto Phase 4, where consonants are next to each other in a words e.g. went, pond, fact Children will access phonics as a whole class session daily and a revisit review at the end of each day before hometime
Literacy 	We will look at a range of texts to support our learning about minibeasts. We will explore both Fiction and non-fiction books, we will also look at poetry and jokes about animals. Within our daily morning writing we will focus on building sentences, using a capital letter and a full stop.
Maths 	In maths we will be using the White Rose Maths scheme; We will cover '20 and beyond' which is all about teen numbers and the number system. Then we will move onto 'First, then, now' which will focus on addition and subtraction number sentences.

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

Topic	This term we will ask the question 'Are we mad about minibeasts?' We will be reading the story of 'Superworm' and will be making our own Wormeries. Within this theme we will explore lots of hands on minibeast experiences. We will be learning about bees and how to look after our world, plating wild flowers for our school wildlife.
Art & Music 	In art we will focus on our artist study of Eric Carle and how he illustrates his stories. We will also be thinking about 3D sculptures, creating bug hotels and models of minibeasts.
P.E. 	This term we will be covering ball skills and games. In games we will be learning rules, keeping score, and trying to work as a team.
