## CLASS NOTICES

### Reading

Children take part in daily reading sessions and activities in school. We ask that you read at home with your child every day. Please bring your child's reading book in on a **Wednesday** so they can be changed. Your child will be bringing home phonic decodable books which are the same as the book they are reading in school. **Please can you check to see if you have any school books at home and return them to school as they are needed by other groups of children.**




### PE

PE will take place on a **Tuesday**. Children can come to school in their kit on PE days. We currently do PE inside in the hall but as the weather begins to improve we may start to do PE outside, so please bear this in mind when choosing your PE kit for the day.





### Homework

Please remember to **look at your child's Tapestry account**. Each week there is information about what your child is learning in school. We would love to see some photos of things your child has done at home e.g. learning phonics sounds, or something which they would like to share in school. We also send home weekly phonics sheets with phonics that your child has learnt in school that week.

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>Phonics</b></p> 	<p>We are continuing to use our phonetic knowledge to help us to read and write. This half-term we will be focusing on using our phonics to help us to read and write sentences.</p> <p>We will be using our Phase 2 and Phase 3 knowledge and begin to learn Phase 4.</p>
<p><b>Literacy</b></p> 	<p>In Literacy, we will be exploring a range of texts linked to our new topic. We will explore fiction texts such as 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' as well as some non-fiction texts to find out information about different minibeasts.</p> <p>We will be creating our own minibeast riddles which we will be sharing on Tapestry.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p>In Maths this half term, we will be looking at numbers to 10 and beyond. We will be focusing on ordering numbers, looking at different ways to make 10 and subtraction.</p> <p>We will also be exploring 2D shapes by creating patterns and pictures.</p>

## ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p><b>Forest School</b></p> 	<p>Children will continue to have a weekly 'Forest School' session.</p> <p>This half term we will be focusing on minibeasts in their habitats. We will go on a minibeast hunt in our outdoor grounds looking closely at what they look like, where they live and what they need to survive.</p>
<p><b>UTW</b></p> 	<p>During this topic, we will be learning lots about different minibeasts. We will look at the life cycle of a butterfly. We will go on our own minibeast hunt in the school grounds and we have an exciting interactive workshop from 'Wild Science' who will bring in some minibeasts for us to see.</p>
<p><b>EAD</b></p> 	<p>We will be designing and making 3D sculpture minibeasts using clay.</p> <p>In Music we are learning songs such as 'Caterpillar' from music express using a range of instruments.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b></p> 	<p>Children will practise and further develop fundamental movement skills through games. They will learn how to score and play by the rules, how to work with a partner and begin to understand what a team is, as well as learn how to behave when losing and winning.</p>
