As the weather gets warmer, please ensure that your child has a summer hat and water bottle in school every day. All children children will still need wellington boots for the garden.

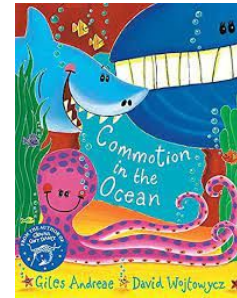
Please make sure your child has a spare bag of clothes on their peg, this is in case they get wet in the water tray.







'Who is making a commotion in the ocean?'

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Phonics</p> 	<p>This term in phonics, we will be consolidating our phase 3 phonemes, and practising applying them in longer words. We will be reading words from Phase 4, where consonants are next to each other in a words e.g. went, pond, fact Children will access phonics in small groups daily, with a whole class session at the end of each day and every Friday.</p>
<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>We will look at a range of texts to support our learning about water. We will explore both Fiction and non-fiction books, we will also look at poetry and jokes about animals. Within our daily morning writing we will focus on building sentences and phrases, using a capital letter and a full stop.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we will be using the White Rose Maths scheme; We will cover looking at patterns of numbers , doubles, halves, addition and subtraction using our number bonds. We will also be looking at drawing maps, solving problems, and using shapes to create new pictures.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Topic</p>  	<p>This term, we will ask the question 'Who is making a commotion in the ocean?' We will start with reading the story of 'The wave" exploring the idea of water, learning the names of the oceans and sea life within them. Within this theme we will explore lots of hands on water play, both inside and out. During this term we will be thinking about recycling and naming different materials. We will be talking about pollution and keeping rubbish out of the seas and oceans.</p>
<p>Art &</p> 	<p>In Art, we will focus on our artist study of monet and how he paints using watercolours. We will also be thinking about 3D sculptures, and creating our own using recycled materials.</p>
	<p>This term, we will be covering both games and ball skills. In games we will be learning rules, keeping score, and trying to work as a team.</p>
