Reading

Your child will be given a colour-banded book to read at home with an adult. When your child has finished their book, the adult should write a comment in their reading record book. Please encourage your child to read at home every day for at least 10 minutes. Adults in school will read with your child weekly. When your child has read their book more than once, it will be their responsibility to exchange it for a new one.

PE

Our PE days are Wednesday and Friday. PE kit must be worn to school on these days. PE kit should consist of black shorts, trousers or leggings and a white T-shirt. Children may also wish to wear a jumper, as these lessons may take place outside. If your child wears earrings, these must be removed on these days, and all other costume jewellery must not be worn.

KINGS & QUEENS

AREAS OF LEARNING

English 	Our key texts for this term are <i>Tell Me a Dragon</i> and <i>Small Knight George and the Royal Chocolate Cake</i>. The children will practise creating and punctuating simple descriptive sentences in their writing.
Maths 	We will be working on numbers within 100 and understanding their value. We will continue practising our counting forwards and backwards. As well as writing numbers as words and forming numbers correctly, we will also learn to add and subtract these numbers.
Science 	This unit is called 'Animals Including Humans - life cycles'. We will be ordering the stages of different life cycles and children will be taught that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
Computing 	In ICT we will investigate how data is collected and categorised using specific attributes. They will create and interpret visual representations, such as pictograms or block diagrams, to answer specific questions.
R.E. 	In RE, the children will learn about the Gospel, the good news of forgiveness, peace and love that Christians believe Jesus brings. They will also explore how Christians follow Jesus' instructions and whether his message is relevant beyond Christianity.

AREAS OF LEARNING

History 	Children will learn about the history of the monarchy by exploring where kings and queens have lived and how these residences have changed over time. Using historical resources such as pictures, they will compare similarities and differences while learning about key monarchs from history.
MUSIC 	We will be learning and performing the song 'Hands, Feet and Heart' as a class. Whilst learning the song, your child will learn different dimensions of music such as pulse, rhythm, and pitch.
D & T 	In D & T, we will explore how mechanisms like linkages and pivots can be used to create movement in designs. Children will design and construct a monster with moving parts, using creative materials to represent features like fur, scales, and claws.
P.E. 	This term, PE lessons will focus on invasion games, where children will learn what possession means and how to support teammates. They will explore attacking and defending skills, including goal-scoring, marking opponents, and applying simple tactics.
PSHE 	Our unit for this term is called <i>Being Me in My World</i>. We will be looking at our hopes and fears for the year, our rights and responsibilities within school, rewards and consequences and creating a class learning charter.
